Our doctorate program is now in its last year and its 7th Network-Wide Workshop Week at the University of Valladolid, Spain (February, from 10th to 13th, 2020) will be the last meeting of our consortium before the final, closure one (Weimar, September 2020). We consider this is an appropriated moment to open our debates to other different perspectives on 20th century Urban History.

Under the title “Current horizons of 20th Century Urban History”, we want to invite you to discuss research approaches close to urbanHist, it means, dealing with 20th Century Urban History but overflowing in different ways the central subject of our project.
